Highnam is a small town situated about 6 km west of Gloucester

From Gloucester:

At Over Roundabout take the first exit onto A40 continue along the dual carriageway and turn right at the traffic lights sign posted B4215. Continue along road for approximately 0.9 km then turn left into Two Mile Lane, Highnam Business Centre can be found on the left hand side.

From the M50

Leave the M50 at Junction 3 B4221 Newent, turn left at Cothar's Pitch, then slight right at B4221 continue along this road for approx 5 km then slight left at B4215. Continue on this road for approximately 10 km then turn right into Two Mile Lane, Highnam Business Centre can be found on the left hand side.

From Bristol:

Take the M32 out of Bristol and join the M4 West bound before taking the first junction onto the M5 North. Continue along the M5 to Gloucester (J12). Follow signs to Gloucester and then take up the directions as above from Gloucester to Highnam.

From South Wales and Forest of Dean:

From Monmouth (reached by A449 from Newport and the M4), take the A4136 towards the Forest of Dean: to reach this you have to cross the A40 and the river. If you are arriving on the A449 this involves doubling back at the second roundabout after emerging from the tunnel, as there is no right turn for the bridge across the river.

Follow signs to Ross on Wye, pick up the A40 and follow signs to Gloucester. Continue on this road for approximately 15 km, you will pass a garage on the right hand side and a sign for Highnam Woods on the left hand side, take the next turning on the left into Two Mile Lane, continue along Two Mile Lane and Highnam Business Centre can be found on the right hand side.

Once you arrive:

Drive in through the Security Gates, you can park in the Off Spill Car Park to the right or turn left into the Business Centre, Severn Wye Energy Agency is the first building on the right hand side.
